Only 51% of gay & bisexual men living with HIV in the United States are Virally Suppressed

In 2016 in the United States,



People with HIV who take their medications as prescribed and maintain an undetectable viral load to sex partners.

81% of new HIV diagnoses among young people ages 13-24 in the U.S. were gay and bisexual men

diagnoses were among gay & bisexual men



Sexually active gay & bisexual men should get tested for HIV at least once a year. Some may benefit from more frequent testing every 3-6 months.



Use a **condom** correctly every time you have sex to protect against HIV and other sexually transmitted infections.



If you are HIV negative, talk to your doctor about PrEP. A daily pill to prevent HIV.

HIV Among Gay & Bisexual Men in Louisiana



Over half of Persons Living with HIV in Louisiana in 2017

Among gay & bisexual men living with HIV in Louisiana... **Hold were age 45 and older** 60% were Black, 34% were White







Over the past 10 years, the proportion of new HIV diagnoses among gay & bisexual men has increased from 46% in 2008 to 64% in 2017.
